Each year UUCSC promotes the 'Guest At Your Table' program offering "Stories of Hope", the effort of the Unitarian Universalist Service Committee, which partners with 73 worldwide, grass roots, organizations in support of Human Rights. Each year just four significant individuals or groups, are selected & their stories are shown on a side of the collection box. We each place a box on our dining tables & put in coins or bills at each meal to remind us to provide help to others.

It begins with the distribution of the Guest At Your Table Boxes and the accompanying descriptive brochures, on the Sunday before Thanksgiving. We continue to publicize this effort, display the boxes & the literature, for the weeks following until winding up the project at the end of January.

The contents of the collected boxes, containing loose change, bills & checks were counted, the names/addresses of the donors were noted, & a report was submitted to the UU Service Cmtee.

The final & absolute total of donations to GAYT (UU Service Cmtee.) is hard to establish, as some folks mail their checks directly to the UUSC. We can report that we donated \$577.50 in directly collected contributions, while recognizing that the final total will be higher. UUSC will subsequently credit UUCSC for the amount of the total contributions.
