UUCSC Directors - Job Description

Directors shall serve as intermediate and long-term planners on behalf of the Congregation. Each Director, with the exception of the Board President, shall act as a liaison, or channel of communication, between the Board and one of the 8 Coordinating Council (CC) clusters designated by the UUCSC bylaws. The Board President is the primary organizer of the CC.

The Directors shall be charged with:

- 1. The planning, research and assessment functions of the Board, and serve as Liaisons to our Coordinating Council clusters and,
- 2. Shall perform such functions assigned by the Board for enhancing the communication and flow of information between and amongst the Board, Committees, and groups, and the members generally.

Specific Duties:

- 1. Conduct Annual Review of Bylaws.
- 2. Conduct Annual Review of new Board initiatives for effectiveness.
- 3. Conduct chalice-side chats.
- 4. Serve as liaison to a Coordinating Council cluster,

Strategic Plans:

- 1. Assess progress toward Board goals for UUCSC.
- 2. Address long-term planning for UUCSC.
- 3. Serve as liaison to groups & committees in a Coordinating Council cluster.
- 4. Conduct efforts to communicate to members individually.
- 5. Actively support UUCSC stewardship efforts.
