How Dining for Dollars (D4\$) Works

1. UUCSC members sponsor dinners, picnics, movie nights, game nights, and other events with varied refreshments, including many with dinners and/or appetizers & desserts, for fellow UUCSC members, families and friends.
2. Beginning after service on April 28th, and continuing through 1:00 pm on May 5th, members and friends may enter bids for events on the bidding sheets in the UUCSC Community Room (or also during the week by phone or email to Betsy Dalton at (401)529-8733, elizabethmdalton@gmail.com). Feel free to bid on events for non-church members as well, both friends and family. All are welcome to participate.
3. Everyone MUST use a bidding number to bid on an event. See the roster in the Community Room (after April 14) for your bidding number. If you don't have a number yet, or forgot it, contact Betsy Dalton, and she will help you get it.
4. Top bids for each event win seats at the table. If you are willing, "It's Yours" Bid (maximum bid) guarantees you a seat at the event.
5. Two events this year (movie nights and chili cook-off) are price fixed – the first folks filling up the bids get to go.
6. All winning bidders will receive a letter about the event(s) approximately one week after bidding closes. You are responsible for making payment when you receive the letter.
7. All proceeds go to the church.
8. Winners are responsible for payment, even if you cannot attend. If you are not able to attend, please send someone of your choosing in your place – just notify the host about who is coming.

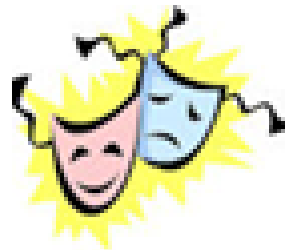

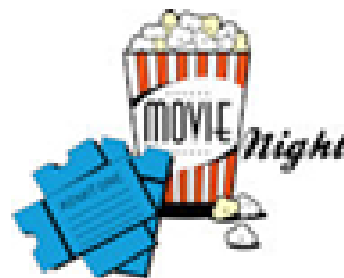
