Extinguishing the Chalice

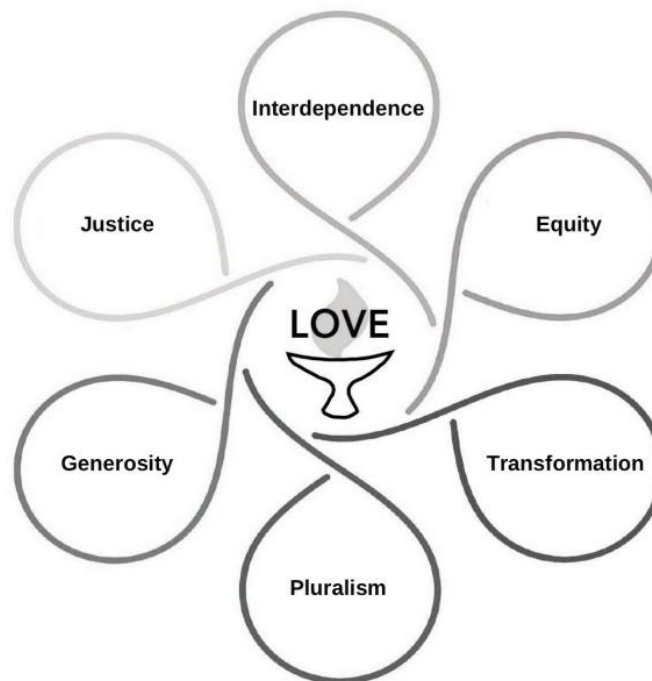
*We extinguish this chalice, but not its light.
